Sparkling & Champagne

1. Topacio Brut, Castellblanch, Cava, Spain

A very easy drinking sparkler from one of the oldest houses making Cava.

2. Champagne R. Barnier, Villevenard, France

Great value Champagne produced only using the Pinot Meunier grape. Not too heavy but with good bottle age and a lovely clean finish

3. Sauvignon V. Pasquiers, Vin de Pays d'Oc, France

A delightful blend of Sauvignon and Vermentino from the Languedoc. Slightly more Depth than a straight variety. Very aromatic.

4. Chardonnay, Casablanca, Vinedos Emiliana, Chile

Exotic tropical fruit aromas of passion fruit and bananas. Full flavours followed by crisp acidity. Unoaked.

5. Pinot Grigio, Adria Vini, Veneto, Italy

A well balanced Pinot Grigio from the quality region of Veneto. Quite delicate with tight lemony fruit opening up to a broader citrus based palate.

6. Chenin Blanc, Paarl Heights, Waterkloof Estate, South Africa

An abundance of tropical fruit on the nose with a crisp lemony twang. Easy drinking style of New World Wines, using wild yeasts.

7. Sauvignon Blanc, Moko black, New Zealand

Zesty citrus & white-stone fruit on the palate with a refreshing finish.

A delightfully expressive Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc

8. K-Naia, Bodegas Naia, Rueda, Spain

A wonderful aromatic blend of indigenous grape varieties plus a touch of Sauvignon. Subtle aromas of opulent tropical fruit; passion fruit, kiwi and guava; Located on the left bank of the River Duero, the winery dedicates itself to the production of high quality white wines.

10. Cabernet Sauvignon Rosado, Bodegas Orvalaiz, Navarra, Spain

From the NE area of Spain comes this lovely deep coloured Rose packed with flavour and body.

11. Pinot Grigio Rose, Ancora, Lombardia, Italy

A fresh fruity wine from this small co-operative in Lombardia, North West of Genova. Lightly pressed

Pinot Noir makes this a great accompaniment to our food.

12. Cabernet Shiraz, Marktree Estate, Australia

Great blend of these 2 familiar grape varieties. Quite peppery yet still smooth on the finish

13. Merlot, Vinedos Emiliana, Rapel Valley, Chile

Delicate blackcurrant fruit, tight tannic profile and deliciously complex finish.

14. Garnacha, Bodegas Borsao, Campo de Borja, Spain

Typically fruit driven wine with soft plum fruit, a hint of blackcurrant and an herbaceous bite on the finish.

From an area renowned for "Grenache"

15. Cotes de Rhone Villages, Georges Darraud, France

This comes from between the Rhone Valley and Provence, using traditional local grape varieties –

Grenache, Syrah & Mourvedre Soft & slightly spicy.

16. Malbec Reserva, Nieto Senetiner, Mendoza, Argentina

Made from 30 year old vines, aged for 10 months in French oak – great value for such quality. Very consistent, perfectly balanced and fab with red meat.

17. Fleurie La Madonne, La Reine d'Arenite, Beaujolais, France

Perfumed, aromatic and with a notable floral twist of violets. Silky and elegant throughout the palate with an abundance of blackcurrant and red berry fruits.

18. Rioja Crianza, Bodegas Altun, Spain

From a small "Boutique" estate comes this full bodied wine with ripe red cherry characters, Good concentration of fruit and balancing acidity. An attractively long finish, with gently spicy balsamic notes.
